Dr **.Lamfon** continued his interest from his practical experience in the clinical field and he was able to obtain a master degree in medical microbiology from King Abdulaziz University and PHD in infection control and epidemiology by Oxford educational network ,IUFS, His success was appreciated by his leaders and he was appointed as a chairman of the JCI subcommittee during the ongoing monitoring of the Joint Commission International Program.

Dr .Lamfon then continued his experience and knowledge by joining the Oxford Educational Network learning scheme and awarded a doctor of philosophy in Infection control & Epidemiology .**Dr** .Lamfon actively involved in teaching and training through conferences, seminars and educational workshops across the kingdom for both governmental and private sectors .**Dr** .Lamfon current job is senior infection control coordinator in the National Guard Hospital Jeddah.
